

Scott Cawelti (b.1943) was born and raised in Cedar Falls, Iowa. He taught writing, film, and literature courses at the University of Northern Iowa from 1968-2008, and has written opinion columns in the Waterloo-Cedar Falls Courier for 35 years. He has co-authored two writing textbooks and edited *The Complete Poetry of James Hearst* (University of Iowa Press, 2001). Having a BA in vocal music, he played for years in a folk duo with Robert James Waller and still performs as a singer/guitarist/songwriter. He released a CD of 16 James Hearst poems set to music and performed for "Landscape Iowa" in 2010. In 2011, Ice Cube Press published his book, *Brother's Blood*, on the Mark family murders.
